## **Acceptance Criteria**

- Students must be enrolled in one of the health professional programs at the University of Toronto (Dentistry, Medical Radiation Sciences, Undergraduate Medicine, Postgraduate Medicine, Nursing, Occupational Therapy, Pharmacy, Physician Assistant, Physical Therapy, Professional Kinesiology, Social Work, Speech-Language Pathology).
