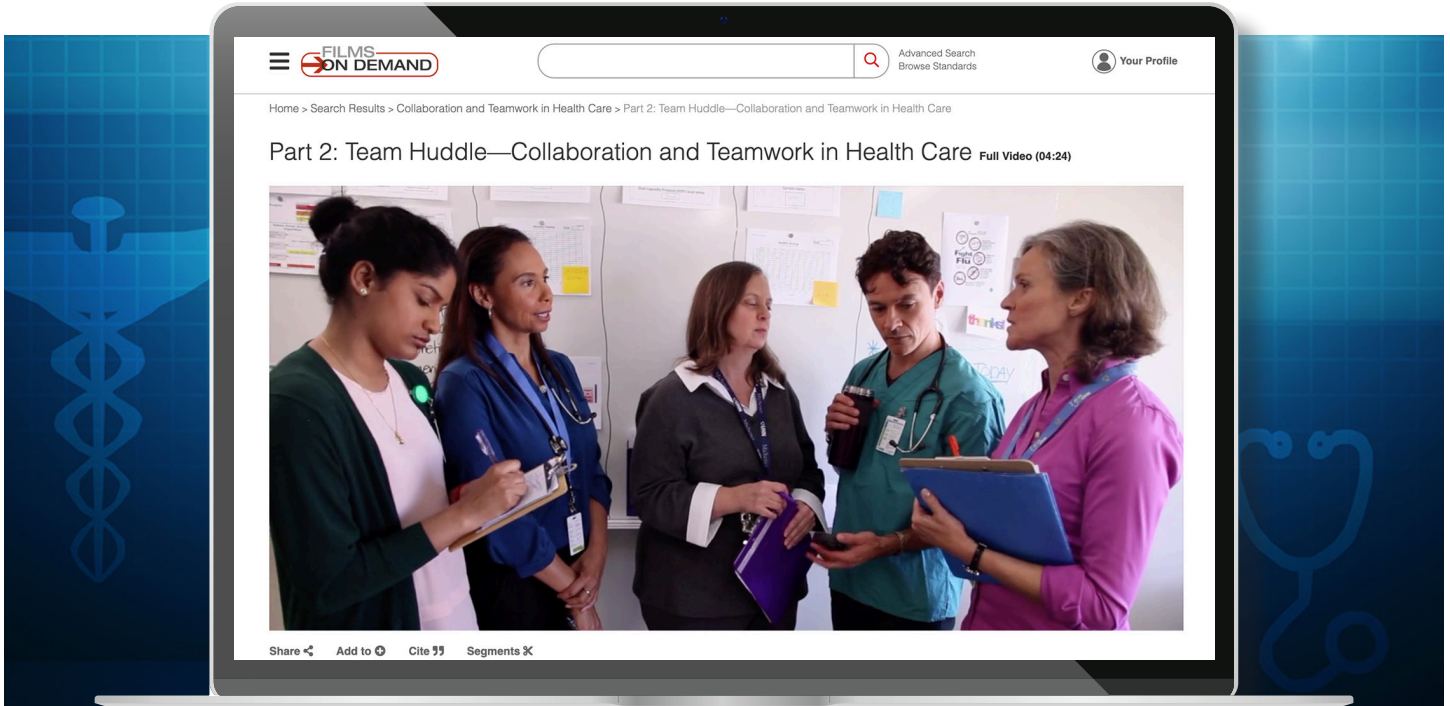

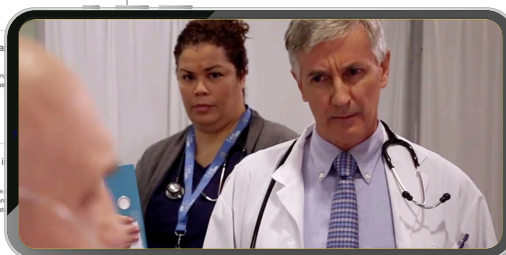
Titles in this Series:

This scenario highlights a good family meeting with effective communication among the patient and the family. The family is fully engaged and is able to share their progress to fully respond to the family.

This scenario highlights the importance of process and communication in the team huddle, when implemented in any setting, help staff to check in with one another as staff attend to work, clinic announcements/emergencies or other staff.

This scenario highlights an example in which different team members bring perspectives on a long-term care resident fall. The team safety debrief meeting is led by the manager. This clip highlights elements such as role clarity, communication, team functioning, and collaborative leadership.
